

Paint vs. Reface vs. Replace

What's the difference?

Painting:

Pros

- Give old doors and drawer front new look
- No Messy tear out required
- Quick and easy process
- Ability to keep existing counters and backsplashes
- Cheapest option of the three

Cons

- Chips and peels easily (careful with cleaning products, kids, and pets)
- Builds up grease a lot more
- Drip marks can remain on cabinets
- Shows wear and tear after 2-3 years
- All hardware, doors, drawers and mouldings remain the same
- Does not add much value to home

Refacing (Cincinnati Cabinet Refacing):

Pros

- All new solid wood doors made by Amish
- All new hard wood veneer
- All new mouldings
- Soft close hinges and drawer glides
- Quality that is very affordable
- No messy tear out required
- Adds amazing value to home
- Lifetime warranty on craftsmanship
- Ability to keep existing countertops and backsplashes
- Quick process (between 3-8 days)
- Ability to recycle old doors, drawers, and mouldings

Cons

- More expensive than painting
- Cannot change entire kitchen layout (minor tweaks can be made)

REPLACE:

PROS

- Brand new cabinet boxes
- New Doors and drawers
- New hardware
- Revamped kitchen layout options

CONS

- Most expensive option
- Messy tear outs
- Long installation and planning process
- Inability to keep existing countertops or backsplashes
